- ➤ <u>Determine Overall purpose</u>: produce landscape, identify systems, resources, data impacting children's health--gaps, then be able to make recommendations.
- Figuring out how to get the group going: piggyback on some of what going on in general in the state re health, such as: Mo Health Net, DSS, currently a Medicaid State plan amendment, CMS(feds), for MO to get Health Homes for Persons w Chronic Illness—one for primary health, one for behavioral health—DOES include birth-5 population. (There is a 90% fed match as far as Medicaid.)
- > Health Insurance exchange
- Federal expansion of poverty level to 130% for Medicaid eligibility
- ➤ FQHC(Roseann)—compelling report from Kevin Gibson, they have implemented a much stronger prenatal and obstetrical program—cut the rate of premature and low birthrate going into neonatal intensive care by 40%.
- ➤ Other possible topics: unnecessary ER visits; childhood obesity; Patsy suggested it might be helpful to identify different data sources, create a map/landscape-- HOW create this landscape—at what level? Perhaps look at the bigger systemic issues before drilling down to program level; Research Kids Count data, data from MO Foundation for Health, re kids' health, rates of uninsured, obesity, etc.
- ➤ Meeting schedule: Mayme discussed a regular meeting/calls schedule these will possibly occur monthly. Work group members were to do a little reconnaissance in certain areas prior to the next meeting, and to review the strategic plan excerpts and other info they will be sent.
