- Consultant Recommendations Regarding Medical Homes/Health Homes
 - MOHealthNet was on the call to explain the Health Home demonstration. There are 24 Health Homes, 18 of which are Federally Qualified Health Centers. There are 2 pediatric Health Homes; they are in Columbia and Bolivar. The most common issues in young children are asthma and obesity. There are 80-90 clinic sites. There were no LPHA's that applied. To apply they need to be a primary care provider and have an Electronic Health Record. There are not many children under 5 enrolled. The state funding will run through June of 2014, they aren't sure of the sustainability after that.

CBEC Mission:
