REQUEST FOR APPLICATION (RFA)

DISCUSSION:

The purpose of this memorandum is to inform staff of a grant opportunity for people who wish to start-up a new or expand an existing child care family home, group home, or center serving children birth through 24 months of age. The funding for this program comes from Missouri Revised Statute Chapter 313, Section 313.835. Its purpose is to build capacity, increase access, and improve the quality of early childhood care and education programs to promote positive child development. County offices may receive calls with questions regarding this RFA.

The RFA was posted April 3, 2009 at the Department of Social Services, Children's Division web site at http://www.dss.mo.gov/cd/early/index.htm. A pre-bid conference is scheduled at 9:00 a.m., April 16, 2009 at the Harry S. Truman Building, Room 492, 301 W. High Street, Jefferson City, MO, 65101. This meeting is open to anyone who is applying for the grant or assisting someone in applying for the grant and provides a chance to clarify any questions regarding information contained in the application.

It should be noted that those persons completing a paper application will not have access to certain edits that are available when using the electronic application. If inquiries are received, applicants should be encouraged to use the electronic version of the application and referred to places within their community where they can access the Internet, such as their public library or local Community Action Agency.

Potential applicants whose facilities will be located in St. Louis City or St. Louis County shall **NOT** complete or submit this child care grant.
