FAMILY SUPPORT DIVISION

From August, 2008 through February, 2009 a FAMIS edit did not allow a child to be authorized to a licensed, contracted provider past 06/30/2009. As a result, there are children whose authorizations to contracted providers will end on 06/30/2009 and the Eligibility Unit (EU) is eligible beyond that date. FAMIS generated a notice (FA601) to these EU's on 05/27/2009 informing the EU that the child's authorization was ending.

For households whose authorizations have not yet been updated in FAMIS, a report listing the EU, child, provider, county office and load number will be distributed by email to county offices. If a county does not have any child authorizations meeting these criteria, no report will be sent.

Staff is instructed to review each EU's circumstances and authorize the children to the contracted provider with a begin date of July 1 or later, if appropriate. Authorizations must be entered by 07/20/2009 in order to prevent interruption of benefits and to avoid payment delays to child care providers.
