The purpose of this memorandum is to inform staff of the revisions made to the FA-150, Action Notice, and the FA-102, Interview Summary. The child protection clause and the change reporting requirements have been added to the FA-150. The change reporting requirements have also been added to the FA-102.

As a result of the revisions made to the FA-150 and the FA-102, the IM-3, Changes You Must Report form is no longer required for child care applications.

The policy manual sections, Setting Up a Case Record, Application Processing, Requests for Child Care Assistance, and Interview Procedures, have been updated to reflect these changes.
