SUBJECT: AUTHORIZING CHILD CARE FOR 23 DAYS A MONTH

DISCUSSION:

The FAMIS/FACES child care system has been updated to allow Children's Division staff the ability to authorize child care for children up to 23 day units in a month when children are authorized for care 5 days a week.

FAMIS has always allowed authorization for up to 25 day units in a month, and Eligibility Specialist are also encouraged to authorize for 23 day units in a month when appropriate.

The authorization of 23 day units in a month will allow for child care providers to be paid for attendance for months with 23 work days, without having to submit a Child Care Provider Payment Resolution Request.
