NOTIFICATION OF CHANGE

House Bill 1111 reduced the income limit for parents/caretakers to receive MC+ from 100% to 77% of the federal poverty level (13CSR 40-2.375). Income information on file for your family indicates your income is above 77% of the federal poverty level. Effective July 1, 2002 the parents/caretakers in your home will no longer be eligible for MC+ healthcare coverage. There is no change in your children's MC+ healthcare coverage.

Eligibility may exist for MC+ healthcare or other medical assistance programs if any of the following apply to parents/caretakers.

- An individual has a physical or mental disability which is expected to last for at least twelve (12) months;
- An individual is pregnant;
- An individual is blind; or
- A change in circumstances has occurred, such as a change in income.

Please contact your MC+ Service Representative at your local Family Service Office if any of the above apply so we may evaluate eligibility for other MC+ healthcare or medical assistance coverage.
