Once in the Red Cross system, the residents will receive vouchers for food, clothing, medicine (if needed), and temporary housing. The Red Cross will ALSO help these residents get into the FEMA tele-registration system.

SHELTER OPERATIONS IN MISSOURI

These accommodations at this time are not for self-evacuees, but for those evacuated by the government.
