
#### **Using MRT Screens**

This user guide is intended to help staff use and understand entries on the FAMIS screens associated with the Medical Review Team.

#### Disabled (FMMX)

The Income Maintenance Eligibility Specialist (ES) pends for a Medical Review Team (MRT) determination by entering the **PMR** (MRT–Pending) code on the **Disabled** screen.



When the doctors at MRT determine whether or not applicant/participant is PTD, MRT staff enters the decision on the MRT Assistance Type Maintenance (FM9C or ASTTMNT) screen. FAMIS searches for and uses the MRT Assistance Type Maintenance (FM9C or ASTTMNT) screen entries to pass or fail on the disability eligibility factor for Adult MO HealthNet programs. Once MRT has entered a decision if the disability determination was the only pending eligibility factor FAMIS creates an ISD. An ISD is created as an entry is required by the Eligibility Specialist on the QMB/SLMB Decision (FMD6) screen before an action can be authorized. Once entry is completed on this screen the Eligibility Specialist authorizes the appropriate decision to:

- Approve or reject applications.
- Continue disability eligibility on reinvestigations.
- Send adverse action notices on reinvestigations.


FAMIS does not update the **Disabled (FMMX or DISABLED)** screen due to differences in program disability definitions. The Eligibility Specialist is responsible for updating information on the

DISABLED (FMMX or DISABLED) screen. The MRT decision for MHABD comes from the screens reviewed below.

Note the F15=MRTINFO function key.

Access MRT screens by pressing 8. MRT Main Menu.



# MRT MAIN MENU (MRTMENU)

MRT staff make entries on MRT screens. MRT screens are inquiry only for IM staff.

Access screens using function keys on related screens and fastpathing.

## MRT MEDICAL MAINTENANCE (FM9B or MEDMNT)

ES sends the medical records to MRT.

MRT receives the records and uses information in the IM-61 heading to enter tracking information on MRT Medical Maintenance (FM9B or MEDMNT).

IM-61 header must have:

- FAMIS USERID
- Load
  - If missing MRT uses the County Manager's information and the manager receives all reminders.
- Application date
  - Reins
    - Date IM2D completed.

Comments on MRT Medical Maintenance (FM9B or MEDMNT) do not replace the doctor's recording on the back of the IM-61. The MRT doctor's notation is on the IM-61. Comments on MRT Medical Maintenance (FM9B or MEDMNT) are rare.

Example - MRT may record a comment if only eligible for one month of the prior quarter.




## MRT ASSISTANCE TYPE MAINTENANCE (FM9C or ASTTMNT)

MRT uses this screen to track medicals they have received and to enter the **Eligibility Decision**, **Decision Date** and **Next Review Date**. This is the screen FAMIS reads to make a correct disability determination.

If the screen is blank press **F6=Further Info** to access the **Further Information Maintenance** screen or use **MOREINFO** fastpath.

Information in the repeating group pertains to the **Application Date** field only.

- Press **F11** and **F12** to see information related to other application dates.
- FAMIS uses the **Next Review Date** field to generate a reminder on the Alert/Reminder List (FM7M or ALREMIND) screen.
  - The Eligibility Specialists receiving the reminders gather and submit the medical information to MRT.

## **FURTHER INFORMATION MAINTENANCE (FM9D or MOREINFO)**


MRT completes **Further Information Maintenance (FM9D or MOREINFO)** when they need more information on the applicant/participant from the ES.

Entries on MOREINFO (FM9B) generate a reminder on the Alert/Reminder List (FM7M or ALREMIND) screen, unresolved reminders elevate to supervisor and county manager after 30 days.


## MEDICAL CODE MAINTENANCE (FM9G or MEDCDMNT)

Code table and definitions used on the MOREINFO (FM9B) screen, seen on Alert/Reminder List (FM7M or ALREMIND) screen.



## MRT 90 DAY RETURN LIST (FM9E or DRTNLST)

Populated automatically from **Further Information Maintenance** (FM9B or MOREINFO) screen. MRT uses this screen to track cases they have requested more information on from the local office.



## MRT VIEW INFORMATION (FM9K or MEDINFO)



**IMDM** screen equivalent. Shows the entire case history in the repeating group.

#### Access:

- FM9K or MEDINFO fastpath.
- F15=MRTINFO key on the Disabled screen when Disabled Rsn field coded:
  - o PMR, MRT PENDING
  - o MRT, MRT DECISION DISABLED 12 MONTHS OR LONGER
