Public Notice Regarding Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinic (CCBHC) Program Administered by the Department of Mental Health

Pursuant to Sections 1902(a)13(A) of the Social Security Act and 42 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 447.205, which mandate that proposed changes in statewide methods and standards for setting Medicaid payment rates be published and made available for review and comment, this is to advise that:

1. The Missouri Department of Mental Health provides notice of the following:

To ensure efficiency, economy, quality of care, and access, a new State Plan for Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinics (CCBHC) is being submitted to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services. The addition of the CCBHC services and CCBHC rate methodology is contingent upon the approval by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services. This State Plan is being submitted under State Plan Transmittal Number 19-0007. Effective for dates of service beginning July 1, 2019, CCBHC services and CCBHC rate methodology will be covered services under the Missouri Medicaid CCBHC program.

Total annual fiscal impact is estimated to be approximately \$365.9 million (\$125.7 million state share and \$240.2 million federal share). Fee for Service fiscal impact is estimated to be approximately \$344.9 million (\$118.5 million state share and \$226.4 million federal share). Managed care fiscal impact is estimated to be approximately \$21 million (\$7.2 million state share and \$13.8 million federal share). Please note that impact shown includes total federal dollars for the program since this is a new SPA. The state has been operating this program under the Section 223 demonstration but because it is new to state plan, full impact was shown.
