## **Public Notice Regarding Prospective 340B Drug Reimbursement Changes**

April 12, 2021

Pursuant to Sections 1902(a) 13(A) of the Social Security Act, 42 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 447.205, which mandate that proposed changes in statewide Medicaid payment methods and standards be published and made available for review and comment, this Notice is to advise that:

1. The Missouri Department of Social Services, MO HealthNet Division provides notice of the following:

State Plan Amendment Attachment 21-0012 is proposed, effective for dates of service beginning July 1, 2021, the MO HealthNet Division (MHD) will change the drug reimbursement methodology for 340B covered entities that choose to carve-in Medicaid. The MHD estimates a total savings of \$36,693,168 annually as a result of this change.

- A. 340B purchased drugs dispensed by pharmacy providers will be reimbursed at their actual acquisition cost, up to the 340B Maximum Allowable Cost (MAC) (calculated ceiling price) plus the professional dispensing fee.
  - a. Covered entities as described in section 1927 (a)(5)(B) of the Social Security Act are required to bill no more than their actual acquisition cost plus the professional dispensing fee.
  - b. Drugs acquired through the federal 340B drug pricing program and dispensed by 340B contract pharmacies are not covered, unless the State approves an exception.
- B. Physician-administered drugs purchased through the 340B program will be reimbursed the lesser of the Physician-Administered 340B MAC or the actual acquisition cost submitted by the provider.
  - a. No professional dispensing fee will be applied to physician-administered drugs.
