Public Notice Regarding Certified Community Behavioral Health Organization (CCBHO) Program

Pursuant to Sections 1902(a)13(A) of the Social Security Act and 42 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 447.205, which mandate that proposed changes in statewide methods and standards for setting Medicaid payment rates be published and made available for review and comment, this is to advise that:

1. The Missouri Department of Social Services along with the Missouri Department of Mental Health provide notice of the following:

To ensure efficiency, economy, quality of care, and access, a State Plan Amendment for Certified Community Behavioral Health Organizations (CCBHO) is being submitted to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services. This state plan amendment updates the effective date for the addition of a new CCBHO provider.

This State Plan will be submitted under State Plan Transmittal Number 22-0038 and be effective for dates of service beginning January 1, 2023.

Total annual fiscal impact is estimated to be approximately \$77,000 (\$26,000 state share and \$51,000 federal share) for MHD clinic services. There is no fiscal impact to the department as these services will be provided out of existing appropriation.
